In Cyprus, we offer weddings with only one or two overnight stays and witnesses for free.

Please note: Upon a wedding in Cyprus, surnames can not be changed. However – if you wish – a certificate of the possibility of a name change can be issued by the registry office. This certificate has to be submitted within 3 months after your wedding day to the authorities of your home country or at a consulate/embassy of your home country in the country of your residence.

The wedding ceremony:

The language of the ceremony is English or Greek. If you do not understand English or Greek, you need an interpreter (price: about 70,- €). Own witnesses may also translate.

Please note: You receive the two marriage certificates directly after the ceremony and an apostille usually one working day after the wedding, unless your wedding takes place until 10.00 a.m.

Legalization / Apostille:

In most countries, you will need an apostille-legalized marriage certificate to register your marriage. Please note: You receive the two marriage certificates directly after the ceremony, the apostille usually the following day. Unless your wedding takes place until 10 o'clock.

Documents:

Please send in **color** scanned copies of these documents by e-mail:

1. Passport or Identity card for citizens of a Schengen member state If you come from a visa-free country: passport; entry stamp* for Cyprus (*if already available)

a valid <u>multiple entry Schengen visa</u>, if you come from a country whose citizens need a visa in order to travel to Cyprus

or

- a valid residence permit for a Schengen state (or a residence permit valid for Bulgaria, Croatia or Romania)
- 2. (International) Birth Certificate if not issued in English, with a certified translation into English
 - 3. An updated certificate of marital status, not older than 3 months by the day of your wedding (please contact us in order to receive country-specific information regarding the marital status proof)
- 4. If divorced or widowed: final divorce decree / divorce certificate or death certificate; if not issued in English, with a certified translation

Authentication/legalization of your documents:

Birth certificates, certificates of marital/family status and divorce decrees / death certificates must be submitted in legalized form: either with an apostill or legalized by the Ministry of Interior/of Justice, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and the Consulate of Cyprus in the issuing country.

The registry office in Cyprus:

Wedding ceremonies take place from Monday to Friday. Personal registration must be accomplished by the couple approximately 30 minutes before the wedding. For a wedding ceremony directly at the registry office, all papers must be submitted not later than about 2 weeks before the wedding day.

Weddings usually take place inside the registry office, but other venues are possible as well (also open-air weddings). Depending on the location, additional fees may be charged.

Costs: starting from about 695, - € - fee of the Registry office, marriage agency fee, apostill/legalization and witnesses service included.

Travel and accommodation costs are not included in the price mentioned above.
